

CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

I have 23 years of Gastroenterology experience; completed post doc fellowship in Gastroenterology (DM) in 2004. Last two decades of practice was a mix up of Gastroenterology, Endoscopy (The procedures list given in a tabular column below), Hepatology& Liver transplant medicine. Eleven years were primarily dedicated to transplant Hepatology, serving Hepatology & Liver transplant units in India & the west.

In 2010, I decided to evolve clinical focus in Hepatology and medical management of Liver transplantation; Spent 9 months at a Canadian liver unit (2010-11) and served as Transplant Hepatologist at Amrita Institute of medical sciences (AIMS), Kochi, Kerala, India (2011-15). AIMS pioneered Liver transplant & Multiorgan transplant in south India; it is predominantly a living donor liver transplant program (93%) and had performed more than 500 cases till 2015. The Canadian liver program where I underwent training was primarily a cadaveric transplant program (120-160 cases /year) with a good proportion of living donor cases as well (In fact, the largest living donor transplant program in North America). I have served as consultant Hepatologist for two more leading liver transplant programs in south India, viz, Gleneagles Global Health city, Chennai & Yashoda group of Hospitals, Hyderabad. Having seen more than 800 liver transplants with a good admixture of Living donor and cadaveric in the east and the west, I have accumulated sound working knowledge on case selection, Pre-liver transplant work up, post transplant management in the immediate postoperative and long term follow up including Immuno suppression, infections and biliary complications. I am quite adept with the interpretation of posttransplant liver biopsies, having spent one and half months in the Transplant Hepatopathology department at Toronto (2011), furthering skills liaising with my hepatopathology colleagues back home in India. While working as Transplant Hepatologist, got interested in End stage liver disease & portal hypertension and in 2015, underwent a Senior clinical fellowship in Hepatology with Hepatic hemodynamics as focus at INSELSPITAL, the University hospital of Berne, Switzerland .At INSEL, I was primarily put in a procedure track with protected research time. The procedure expertise gained during this tenure at Berne pertains to Portal Hypertension-Hepatic vein pressure gradient measurement (HVPG), Trans jugular liver biopsy (TJLB) and Trans jugular intrahepatic Porto systemic shunt placement (TIPS).

I have served as Assistant Professor in Gastroenterology & Hepatology at JIPMER, Puducherry, Consultant Hepatologist



for National Health Services (NHS), UK at Queen Alexandra Hospital, Portsmouth, Director of Transplant Hepatology at Yashoda group of Hospitals, Hyderabad and senior consultant Hepatologist& Liver transplant physician at Gleneagles Global Health City, Chennai. After 2020 March, during COVID years, I have been working as visiting Consultant at multiple health care facilities in Kochi. In addition to the main practice locations, I conduct regular outreach clinics at few suburban locations in Kerala.
